In the Republic of the Congo, private radio and television stations are allowed alongside the public broadcaster, Radiodiffusion Television Congolaise. Freedom of speech is severely curtailed in the country.

How many TV stations are in the Democratic Republic of the Congo?

Since 1990 many television stations have been broadcasting in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. In 2006, 58 television channels were available. Of these, 38 are in Kinshasa. The Democratic Republic of the Congo has many radio stations, the majority of which are based in Kinshasa.

What is mobile internet penetration in the DRC?
